**Extant Roundhouse Survey Returns**

We need your help on a project of interest to the Society. We have resurrected the Extant Roundhouse Survey. It is updated to include additional properties and changes in status. Our goal is to expand this record of all the existing roundhouses remaining in the United States. This listing is possible only through the efforts of the members of this society.

How can you help? In every chapter there are members familiar with existing roundhouses. We are asking you, as chapters and as members, to compile and forward basic data for compilation, whether updates to existing listings, or new properties. The amount of data gathered varies from structure to structure, We ask for several levels of information in order to tailor each effort based on time available and the people gathering the data. The information requested consists of BASIC DATA (Level 1), INTERMEDIATE DATA (Level 2), and based upon interest and availability, DETAILED DATA (Level 3).

The Data Request Form and two versions of the HRSS Extant Roundhouse Survey are posted on the NRHS Administrative website (<https://admin.nrhs.com/> ). The 17x11 version consolidates all the data on three sheets, and is simpler to use when scrolling on the computer. The 11x8.5 version is suitable for printing on letter-sized paper stock.

NORTH TEXAS CHAPTER, NATIONAL RAILWAY HISTORICAL SOCIETY, MINUTES, DATE: September 10, 2019.

The September 2019 meeting of the North Texas Chapter of the NRHS was held on Tuesday, September 10 at the Spring Creek BBQ in Grapevine, TX. Nineteen (19) were in attendance.

Chapter President Wayne Smith called the meeting to order at 7:45 PM. He recognized several attendees, including Virginia, who celebrated her 90th birthday; Robert Haynes, formerly with the Plano Interurban Museum; and William (Bill) Franz.

VP Skip Waters, representing NRHS District 7, presented a 25-year NRHS Membership plaque and letter to Bill Franz, long-time member of the North Texas Chapter.

Wayne Smith recognized guests Robert Haynes and his friend Tony. Robert is now affiliated with the African American Museum located at the Texas State Fairgrounds in Dallas, TX. He is currently writing a book entitled African American Railroad Experiences, documenting the contributions the African American community made to the American railroads from its early construction to the present. Robert was encouraged to apply for a grant from the NRHS to help fund the project.

#### Thursday, November 7

Registration opens at 3pm. 6pm, attend a reception at the DeGolyer Library on the SMU Campus. This library holds the NRHS National archives. Learn about the collection and a chance to purchase duplicate books from their collection. Light food and beverages to be served. **Cost \$25.**

#### Friday, November 8

**(Part A)** Morning group tour of the DFW Transit/Commuter rail lines to include, DART, Trinity Railway Express, TEXRail, Dallas Streetcar. Lunch is OYO (on your own) in the historic Bishop Arts District via the Dallas Streetcar. **Afterwards, you will have 3 choices to enjoy your afternoon.**
